LAKE LOU YAEGER AMENITIES

HIKING/TRAILS:

- Route 66 Hike & Bike Trail: 6.6 miles round trip.
 - Trailheads located at each playground and picnic area.
 - Bathrooms available until October 31.
 - Picnic areas, benches, and repair stations available.
- Shoal Creek Conservation Area: 3/4 mile round trip.
 - Located on the east side of Lake Lou Yaeger.
- Equestrian Trails: 25 Miles of looping trails.
 - Accessible from Equestrian Campground.
 - Day riding available from the same location.

MILNOT BEACH: MEMORIAL DAY—LABOR DAY

- Sand beach, complete with inflatable playground, rope swing, diving boards, rock walls, and snack bar.

- Party/Meeting Room available for rental all year long.

FISHING/BOATING:

4943 Beach House Trail, Litchfield, IL 62056

- Lake Lou Yaeger is 5.5 miles long/1400 acres.
- Daily and annual boat passes can be purchased a Marina 1.
- Boats are not restricted to a horsepower limit.
- Common fish: Crappie, Bass, Bluegill, and Catfish.
- Marina 1 sells boat passes, bait, snacks, and Lake Lou Yaeger merchandise, as well as fuel during normal operating hours.
